Covid-19 Guidance/Changes



We are looking forward to the day when this newsletter won't need a Covid 19 section – alas, it's not this term as we might have hoped. You will have seen the letter earlier

this week from the Director of Education which explains that, due to the still high number of Covid cases, the mitigations put in place last term will need to continue into term 2. Thank you to everyone for continuing to follow the guidelines by wearing facemasks, not coming into the playground and maintaining social distance from other adults.

We continue to recommend that children wear their PE kits into school and keep them on all day for PE days.

Please ensure you are aware of the guidance around selfisolation for close contacts of someone who has tested positive and please remain vigilant. If you or your child(ren) display any of the symptoms of Covid-19 please stay at home and get a test as soon as possible.

One word of caution; at one point this week Aberdeenshire had the highest rate of positive Covid cases across all of Scotland. The virus is still very much with us so please take care.



Outdoor Clothing

The weather has definitely taken a turn for the worse but that's not going to stop

us getting the children outside as much as possible. Please continue to ensure your child has clothing suitable for wet and cold conditions. Our school wellies are always available and easy to access at break and lunch times as well. We also have overalls to keep out some of the dirt and rain! Please remember to use the hi-viz vests as the nights get darker. If your child has a hi-viz vest that no longer fits can we please ask you return this so it can be passed on to someone else. If you child requires a new hi-viz vest please let us know.

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School Building Upgrade

Any parents who have been dropping off/picking up children from school will have noticed that we have been having all our windows upgraded. That work started the last week of term 1 and was completed by the time we came back last Monday. A great job and with minimum disruption to the school. This means that we should now be able to keep the classrooms warmer and we can open the windows to provide proper ventilation. The facia boards are also in the process of being replaced and I had a meeting last week to discuss a replacement heating system for the lower part of the school. On a smaller scale - thanks to Nathan and Barnaby's family for the donation of a fridge for the school staff room.

Pantomime and other Performances

We have provisionally booked the Christmas panto at Aberdeen Arts Centre this year. Fingers crossed this will still be able to go ahead in December. This year, following discussions with the staff and the pupil council we have decided not to do a full-on Christmas show. We are hoping that Covid restrictions will have eased by the summer term and we would love to be able to invite you all in to school to see an end of year show instead. We are still really keen to do something for Christmas though, so we are going to hold a Carols by Candlelight evening outside instead - that way we'll be able to invite you all along (and keep within current Covid guidance). New School Values

If you were able to attend our virtual assembly at the end of last term you may remember that we had a 'dotmocracy' vote to determine pupil preferences for our new school values. This is part of a process to create new vision, values and aims for our school. We started it two years ago but, thanks to Covid, we were never able to finish, so we are set on completing it this year. The values chosen by the children were: Kindness, Trust and Honesty, and Determination. It was fantastic to see all the children thinking hard about this and taking their voting responsibility seriously. I think the values they have chosen are very well considered; I'd be really happy if every child who leaves Arnage school is kind, honest and determined to achieve the best they can. These values are really important to the school and they will inform everything we do day-to-day; we'll soon be sending out a feedback form to get your thoughts and opinions on this so please take a few minutes to complete this.
