School Dress Code

We are very keen to return to our usual school dress code and encourage you to



send children in their school uniform every day as much as you are able. We also ask that children bring in their gym kit and change in school on PE days. These are the items listed in our handbook:

- a navy-blue sweatshirt/cardigan with or without the school logo
- white or navy polo shirt also available with the school logo
- black, grey or navy skirt/trousers, checked dress for summer wear
- a navy fleece and a navy waterproof jacket with the school logo is also available
- indoor shoes, preferably black gym shoes, should be worn

School uniform can be purchased directly from our supplier, **Pomprint** in Mintlaw.

The parent council and the school have quite a large stock of second hand, hardly used items. Please get in touch if you'd like any help with school clothes - we are acutely aware of the difficulties many families are facing in the current financial climate.
